

- Given rise to new disciplines


#### **Discovery research information**

Target identification; target validation; lead identification; lead optimisation; preclinical technology, CMC, Pharmacology/Tox.

- Sources of information come from

Pharmacogenomics is used to identify the genetic basis for individual response to medicines; thus can identify why side effects occur in some but not others. Personalised medicine or – the right medicine for right patient.

#### Characteristics

- Evaluated information for a specific group or user
- Information provision sometimes a secondary objective (Associations)
- Not always available to non-members
- Commentaries, value-added, organised
- Quality varies from excellent to variable
- Often unique information



Regulators

- Increased pressure to shorten the regulatory review times
- Focus on safety and more risk-averse
- Pressure for more frequent and early dialogue with manufacturers
- Increased transparency of activities
- Web sites now become a good source of information on the progress of products
